**Vendor Guidelines**

Gates will be open on Saturday, from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and Sunday, from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Your stand should be open during these times if at all possible.

1. ENTRY FEE: Each space will be \$85.00 if paid before May 1. After May 1, each space will cost \$95.00 for craft vendors and food vendors. Make checks payable to "Honor the Firekeepers" powwow and mail to Patricia Kobeissi.
2. ASSIGNMENTS: No participant will be allowed to exhibit without payment of entry fee. No splitting of booth space. Each space will be a 12' X 12' area. **NO TABLES OR CHAIRS WILL BE PROVIDED!** This is an outdoor event, so please be prepared.
3. PETS: We are asking that you **NOT** bring your pets with you, but if you do; You need to please keep them secured at your area, walk them away from the powwow grounds, pick up after them and dispose of the waste properly.
4. ELECTRICITY: There is **NO** electricity on this field. Generators will be allowed as needed.
5. LIABILITY: Powwow committee shall not be responsible for the loss or damage to works of art and/or property of vendor. All exhibitors are responsible for their own displays.
6. ITEMS YOU CANNOT SELL: Pipe stone, items made of pipe stone, or herbs. We are asking for all Native-made items. **NO "Made in China" items** will be permitted for sale, as this is a Native American event.
